Dear Mayor / Reeve, Councils and Administrator,

This Letter is intended to provide an update from the WaterWolf Executive Board and the Administration regarding issues that we are addressing at the present time.

**Asset Management**

WaterWolf had the great honor of being asked to present to the Federation of Canadian Municipalities at a conference. We thank administrators Yvonne Jess of the Village of Elbow and Resort Village of Mistusinne and Vanessa Tastad of the RM of Loreburn, along with Clayton Drewlo of Urban Systems for presenting the WaterWolf regional experience in Asset Management.

FCM has their Municipal Asset Management Program (MAMP) still open. They accept applications by the end of each month – there is AMP funding available! More detailed information will be sent by next Monday, April 2 to see what municipalities are interested in this and further training. FCM covers 80% of the cost!

**Board Member Meetings**

The Board had a meeting on March 22nd. Attached are the minutes from the February 15th meeting. After the next board meeting, the approved minutes for March will be sent out. The next Board Member's meeting is Monday, April 23rd, 2018.

**Member Meeting**

A members' meeting is being held on Thursday, April 5<sup>th</sup> at 6:30 pm at the Loreburn Town & Country Centre – 501 Main St. This meeting will target 2 specific areas of interest: Emergency Plans and Aquatic Invasive Species. For the Emergency Plans – we have a speaker from the Government of Saskatchewan to talk about a regional plan (FREE) option. We also have a speaker from Data Safe Systems regarding a plan that can be done and maintained (\$\$) for you. The 3<sup>rd</sup> speaker is from the Department of Fish, Wildlife and Lands to discuss the prevention of aquatic invasive species from being introduced into Lake Diefenbaker.
